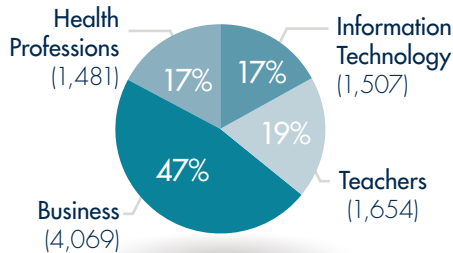

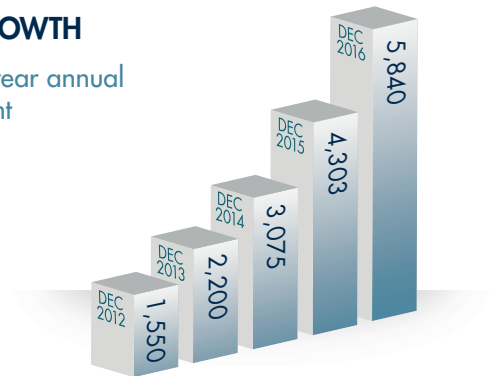
GROWTH IN CUMULATIVE GRADUATES

STUDENT SNAPSHOT

- The average student age is 37.5; student ages range from 18 to 75.

 - 41% ethnic minorities
 - 25% low-income families
 - 9% rural area residents
